**MISSION TRIPS TO DOMINICAN REPUBLIC** - The Diocese is committing to three missions to the Dominican Republic in 2008. The first, a construction team, is scheduled for **February 23<sup>rd</sup> - March 2<sup>nd</sup>**; the second, a medical/dental team, **March 1<sup>st</sup> - March 9<sup>th</sup>**; and the third, a smaller medical team and a youth team, **June 14<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup>**. The current funds in the Diocesan budget are not sufficient to fully support these mission trips. Medicines and equipment account for the greatest expense. In addition, though each missionary pays their own airfare, the mission pays for lodging and meals for the week, as well as transportation to and from the village each day. Each congregation in the Diocese is asked to consider participating in the "Mile of Dimes" campaign by putting out a collection container for folks to drop in their "spare change" each Sunday. The hope is that these dimes will grow into dollars to help fund these mission trips. Remember, no amount is too small!
