NEW 53RD ANNUAL DIOCESAN CONVENTION - DATE AND DELEGATE ELECTIONS

The 53rd Annual Diocesan Convention is scheduled to be held February 23-24, 2024, at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Daphne. Save-the-date on your calendars! Now is the time to plan for your delegate elections! All delegates must be elected and certified by Sunday, December 24, 2023 (no later than 60 days prior to the start of the diocesan convention, in accordance with Canon 3, Sections 4 and 5). The timeline of important convention dates is located at the bottom of this document.

ANNUAL ENROLLMENT FOR 2024 HEALTH BENEFITS Annual Enrollment for 2024 Medical / Dental plans for eligible clergy / lay employees has now closed. Remember, our dental provider has moved from Cigna to Delta Dental. You should be receiving your new cards in mail in the next month (or can download). Don't forget to take your new card information with you when you visit your health providers next year.

CHANGE IN DENTAL INSURANCE

Currently the Church Pension Group offers dental insurance through Cigna Dental; eligible / retired clergy and lay employees are offered 3 different dental plans. Over the past year CPG completed an RFP to determine future dental plan offerings. As such, they have selected a new dental provider (Delta Dental), effective January 01, 2024. This is a network change so during Annual Enrollment (AE) members will be required to make new selections for 2024. If you want dental coverage but did not log-in to make this selection during annual enrollment, please contact Kim or Dwight immediately.

NEW PROPERTY/LIABILITY INSURANCE CHANGES

Unfortunately, the cost of property / casualty insurance in the Gulf Coast states have skyrocketed, especially in Florida. Many of our churches have maintained a very low AOP deductible (eg. \$1000) which means they are paying some of the highest premiums for their coverages. The Diocese looked at all churches with \$1000 deductible and found that all would save if they moved to a \$2,500 AOP deductible at a minimum. As such, all churches with a \$1,000 AOP deductible will migrate to \$2500 deductible in 2024, unless the church formally requests to remain at \$1,000. CHANGES TO THE ONLINE SAFEGUARDING / RISK MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Our Safeguarding system has migrated to a new platform. You can find links and guidelines on the diocesan website at: https://www.diocgc.org/administrative-resources The name of this program changed from "Armatus" to "Praesidium Academy." Each church must identify church Administrators; Admin's can be added to the system by contacting the Diocesan Office. These Admins will add their church members to the Academy system and generate "invitations" to those needing to take Safeguarding modules.

To Sign Up for new Safeguarding system:

- 1. E-mail the Safeguarding Online Administrator assigned to your parish.
- 2. Your designated church Administrator will facilitate your access to Praesidium Academy by generating an "invitation email" which will be sent to you from donotreply@praesidiuminc.com.
- 3. Fill in the required information (including your desired password).
- 4. Click Accept Invite.
- 5. You will be redirected to the login screen please log in with your email address and the password you just created.
- 6. You can now proceed to find and complete the required modules.

If your coursework is over 4 years old, it will be considered dated/expired and may not have been moved over into your new account. If you have any questions, please contact Dwight Babcock or Mary Poss at 850-434-7337.
