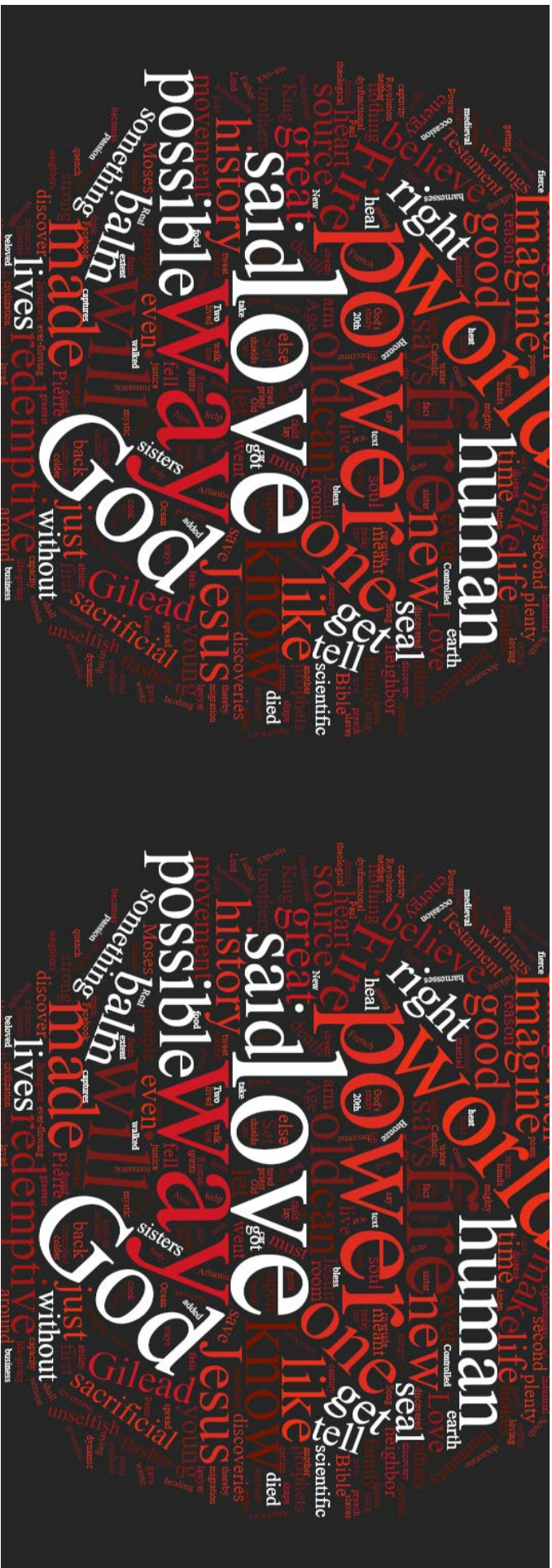
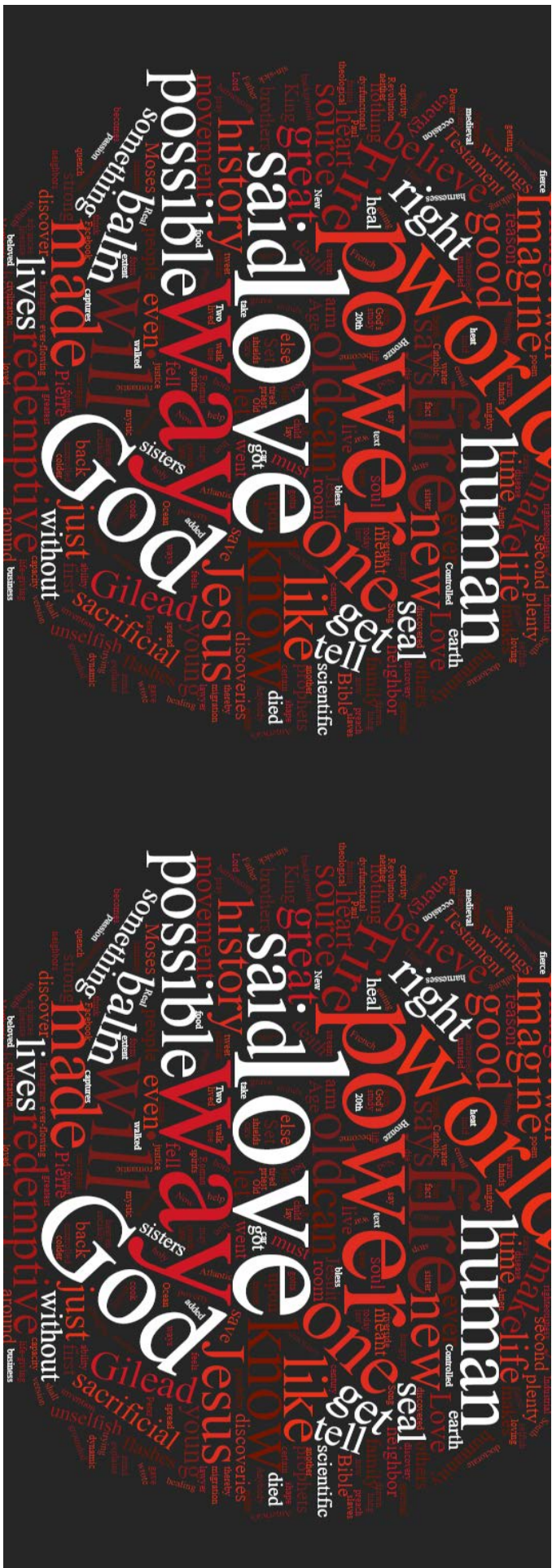

things right.

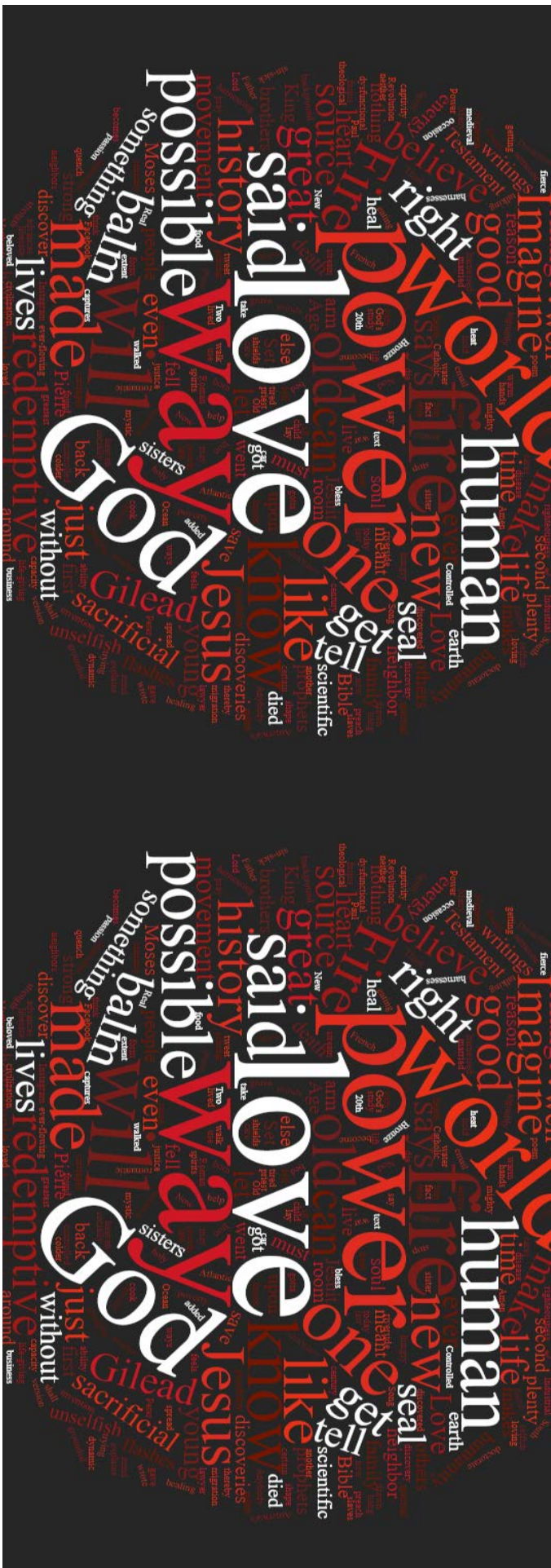
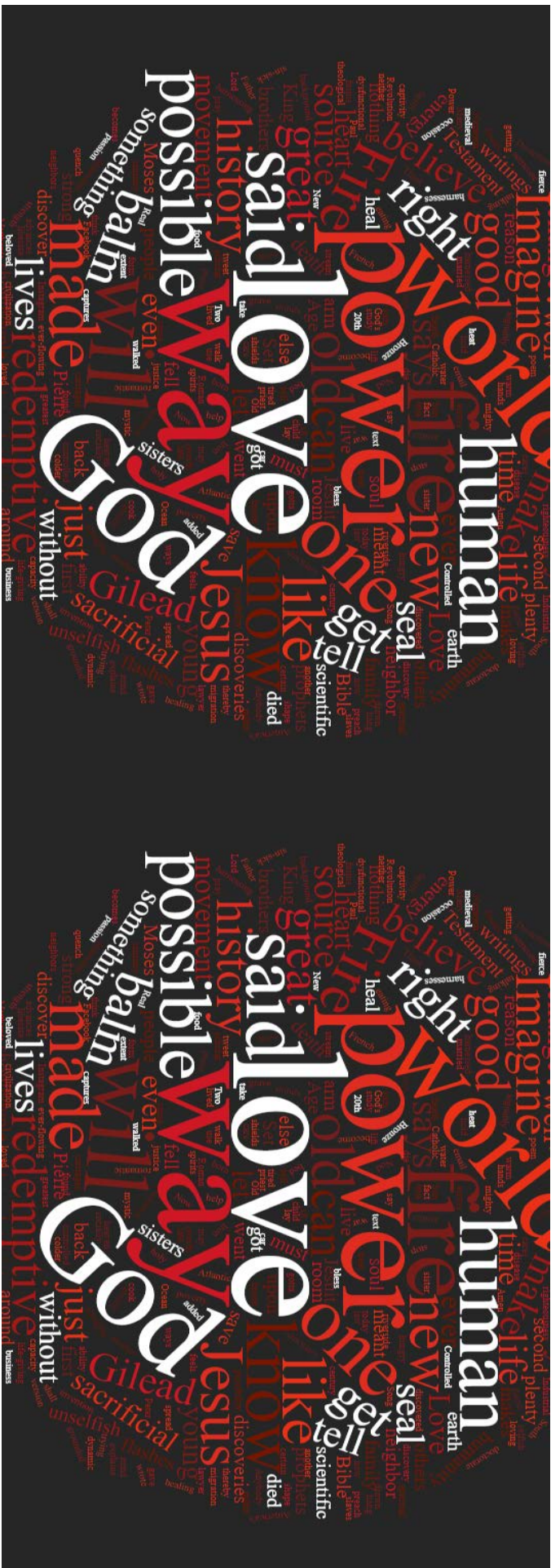
Described a time in your
