NEW IRS MILEAGE RATE CHANGE

For the final 6 months of 2022, the standard mileage rate for business travel has increased 4 cents from 58.5 cents to **62.5 cents per mile**, effective July 1, 2022. In recognition of recent gasoline price increases, the IRS made this special adjustment for the final months of 2022. The IRS normally updates the mileage rates once a year in the fall for the next calendar year. NEW EPISCOPAL CHURCH STREET SIGNS NOW AVAILABLE FROM FORWARD MOVEMENT

Forward Movement has announced it is the new official home of Episcopal Church street signs, having acquired the business from Faith Goods, part of Day1, in late 2021.

For more than a half century, the "Episcopal Church Welcomes You" street sign has been used as a highly visible community invitation for churches. Visitors and inquirers may search the internet for directions to local churches, but they also recognize a familiar sign when they see it. Local signage is a valuable strategy for churches to maintain visibility and a distinct brand identity for continued growth and development.

"Street signs are evangelism, plain and simple, but with huge potential impact. They help with community visibility for all churches, especially those located on side streets and outside city centers," said the Rev. Canon Scott Gunn, executive director of Forward Movement. "We're excited to help churches refresh their signage to help them reach more disciples."

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS RESOURCES

As we head into hurricane season, now is the perfect time to review your church's emergency preparedness plan and procedures. It is critical to have updated contact information readily available for church leadership and to identify your church's most vulnerable population in the event of a local emergency situation - like extreme weather. Equally important is to have checklist of how to secure your church facility and property or prepare for unexpected issues such fire, potential violence, active shooter. TECHNOLOGY SAVINGS FOR NON-PROFITS

Remember that all churches have an account created for them on TechSoup, a technology non-profit that provides access to many tools for other non-profits donated by key companies such as Microsoft, Intuit, Adobe, Dell, etc. This allows your church to purchase software, hardware, courses, and other technology services at greatly discounted rates. CHANGES TO THE ONLINE SAFEGUARDING / RISK MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Our Safeguarding system has migrated to a new platform. You can find links and guidelines on the diocesan website at: https://www.diocgc.org/administrative-resources The name of this program changed from "Armatus" to "Praesidium Academy." Each church must identify church Administrators; Admin's can be added to the system by contacting the

Diocesan Office. These Admins will add their church members to the Academy system and generate "invitations" to those needing to take Safeguarding modules.

To Sign Up for new Safeguarding system:

- 1. E-mail the Safeguarding Online Administrator assigned to your parish.
- 2. Your designated church Administrator will facilitate your access Praesidium Academy by generating an "invitation e-mail" which will be sent to you from donotreply@praesidiuminc.com.
- 3. Fill in the required information (including your desired password).
- 4. Click Accept Invite.
- 5. You will be redirected to the login screen please log in with your e-mail address and the password you just created.
- 6. You can now proceed to find and complete the required modules.

If your coursework is over 4 years old, it will be considered dated/expired and may not have been moved over into your new account. If you have any questions, please contact Dwight Babcock or Mary Poss at 850-434-7337.
