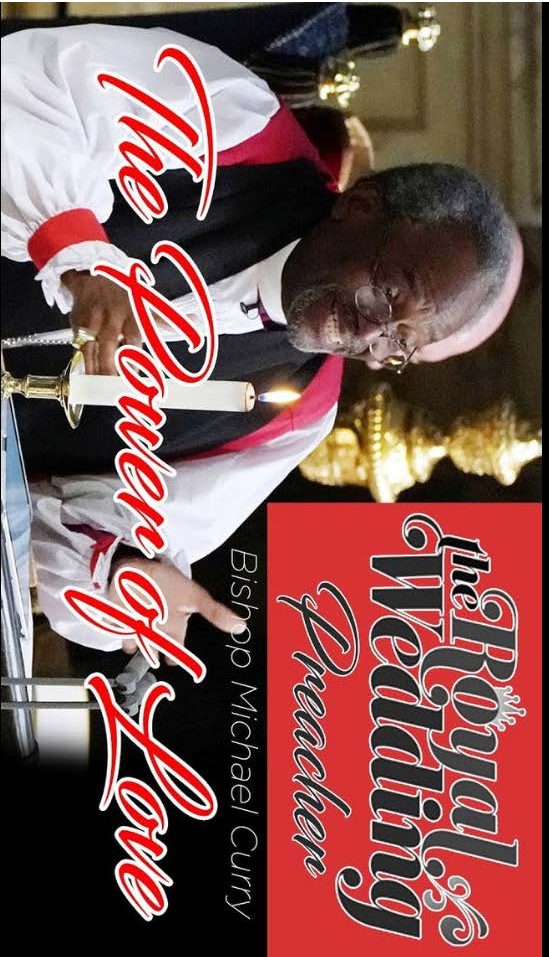

right.

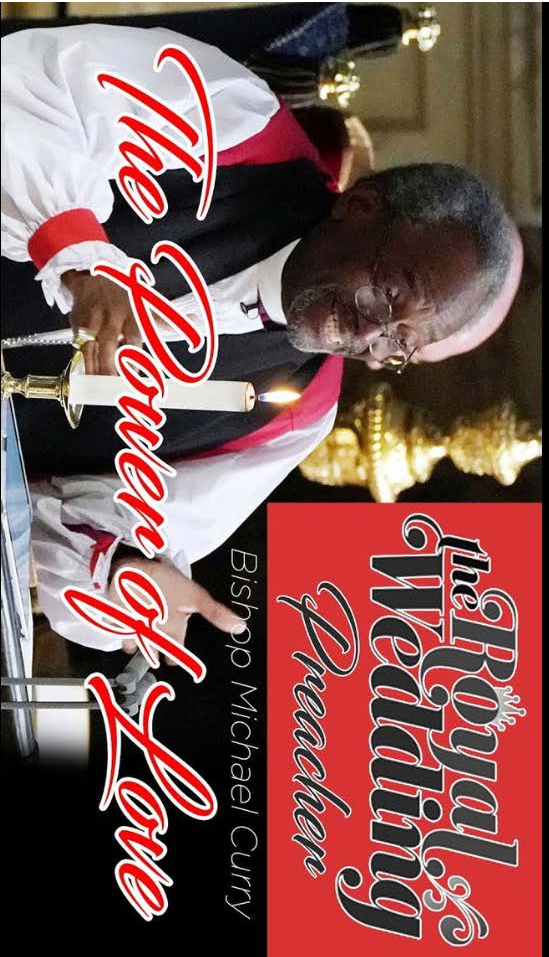

– Michael Curry

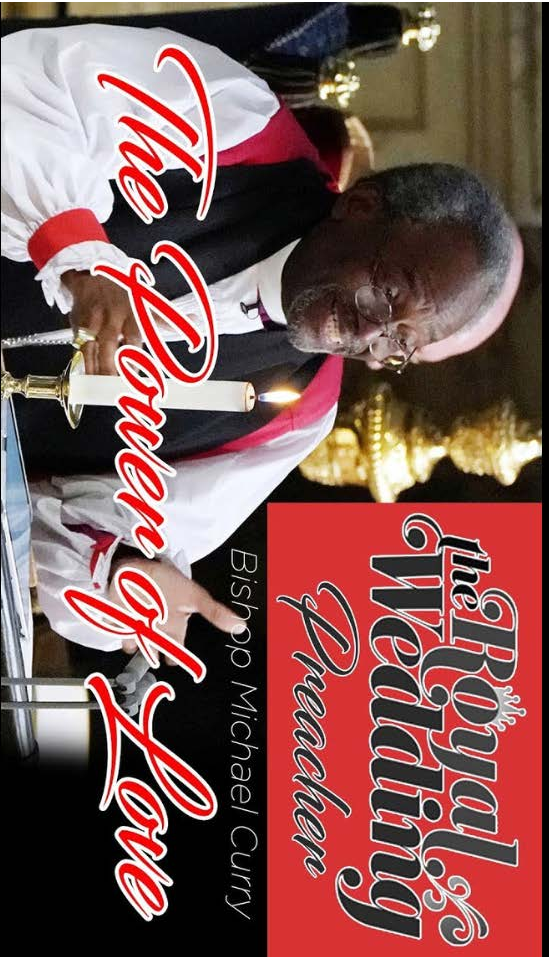
**When have you found

destruction?**

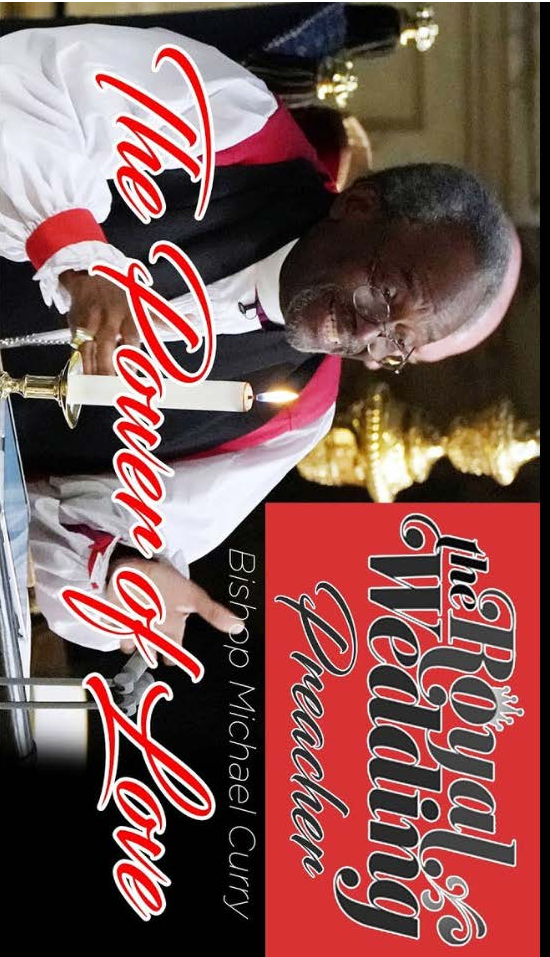
During the address,
